Dr. Taylor Worley

Dr. Taylor Worley serves as Associate Vice President for Spiritual Life and University Ministries and as Associate Professor of Faith and Culture at Trinity International University in Deerfield, Illinois. He is also the Managing Director of The Resilience Project for the Center for Transformational Churches at Trinity.

He completed a Ph.D. with the Institute for Theology, Imagination, and the Arts at the University of St. Andrews in the areas of contemporary art and theological aesthetics. His scholarly projects center on theological explorations of the visual arts and cinema as well as engaging Dietrich Bonhoeffer's Christological sociality for the church in the world. He has lectured on diverse topics in a theological engagement with contemporary art and film at conferences and in churches.

Worley has been involved in or edited several book projects. He serves on the executive team of the board of directors for the artists' network Christians in the Visual Arts, a diverse community of artists and creatives who represent many Christian traditions and are committed to serious art with a serious faith.
