When Applying:

Master Promissory Note

A Master Promissory Note (MPN) is the legal agreement between you and the government, who is your lender. It is your promise to repay the loans after leaving school. The information collected is done through a secure website. You will need your PIN number from the FAFSA to electronically sign the form. If you are unable to complete the process online, you may do so in person by scheduling a time to meet with someone in the financial aid office.

Stafford Loan Entrance Counseling

All students who choose to use student loans in financing their education are required to complete an entrance counseling session before receiving their funds. If you cannot complete the process online you may do so in person by scheduling a time to meet with someone in the financial aid office.

Stafford Loan Exit Counseling

All students who have utilized student loans in financing their education are required to complete an exit counseling session before graduating or dropping below half time status. The interview can either be completed online by following the link below or done in person by scheduling a time to meet with someone in the financial aid office. The counseling session provides information about how to manage your student loans after college.
